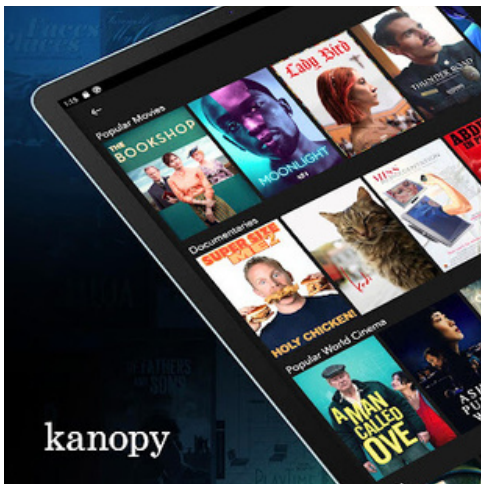

Access ebooks, audiobooks, comics, and magazines

Getting started

1. Install the **Libby** app from the Amazon Appstore on your Fire tablet.
2. In Libby, follow the prompts to find your library and sign in with a valid library card.
3. Browse your library's collection and borrow a title.
4. Borrowed titles appear on your **Shelf** and download to the app automatically when you're on Wi-Fi, so you can read them when you're offline.

More you can do

On your **Shelf** () , tap **Loans** at the top of the screen. From there, you can:


- Tap **Read With...** to choose whether you'd like to open a book in Kindle or Libby
- Tap **Open In Libby** to start reading or listening in the app
- Tap **Manage Loan** to see options like **Renew Loan** and **Return Early**

Access ebooks, audiobooks, comics, movies, and music

Getting started

1. Install the **Hoopla** app from the Amazon Appstore on your Fire tablet.
2. Sign up with your library card and create an account. You will use the username and password you set to log into Hoopla going forward.
3. Browse the collection and borrow a title. Remember, each person is limited to 6 borrows per month, so choose carefully.
4. Tap **Read** or **Play** to enjoy!

More you can do

- Tap on **My hoopla** to view your current titles
- Use the **Search** function to look up titles
- Tap the  icon next to a title to add it to your **Favorites**
- Tap on **Download to your device** for offline use

Access movies and TV shows

Getting started

1. Install the **Kanopy** app from the Amazon Appstore on your Fire tablet.
2. Swipe through the welcome pages and tap on **Sign Up**.
3. Create your Kanopy account using your email address and a password.
4. You will receive a verification email at the address you used to sign up - click the link in the email to verify your address.
5. Follow the prompts on the app to choose your library and add your card information.
6. You're all set! Select a film to start watching. Each person has 24 tickets per month. Ticket cost varies by item.

More you can do

- Use the **Search** function to look up titles
- Tap the **+** icon below a title to add it to your **Watchlist**
- Tap the **≡** icon to access your **Watchlist** or browse genres
